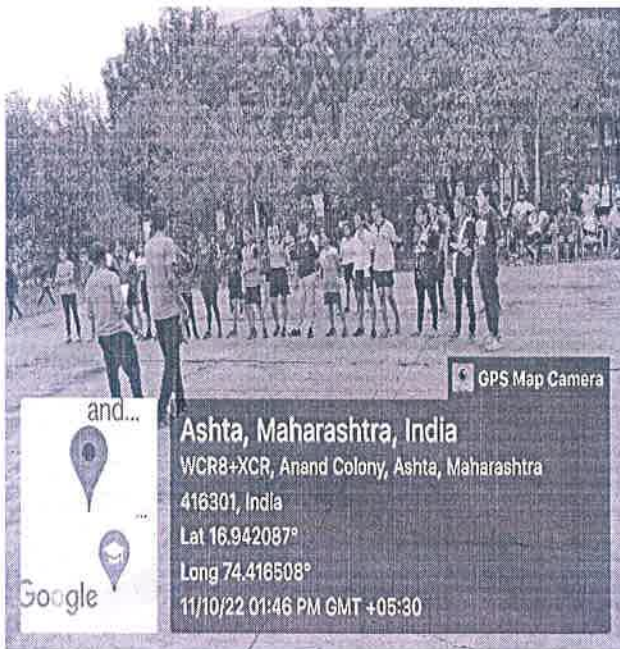
The MUHS zonal trials were held at Kolhapur from 9th October to 11th October.





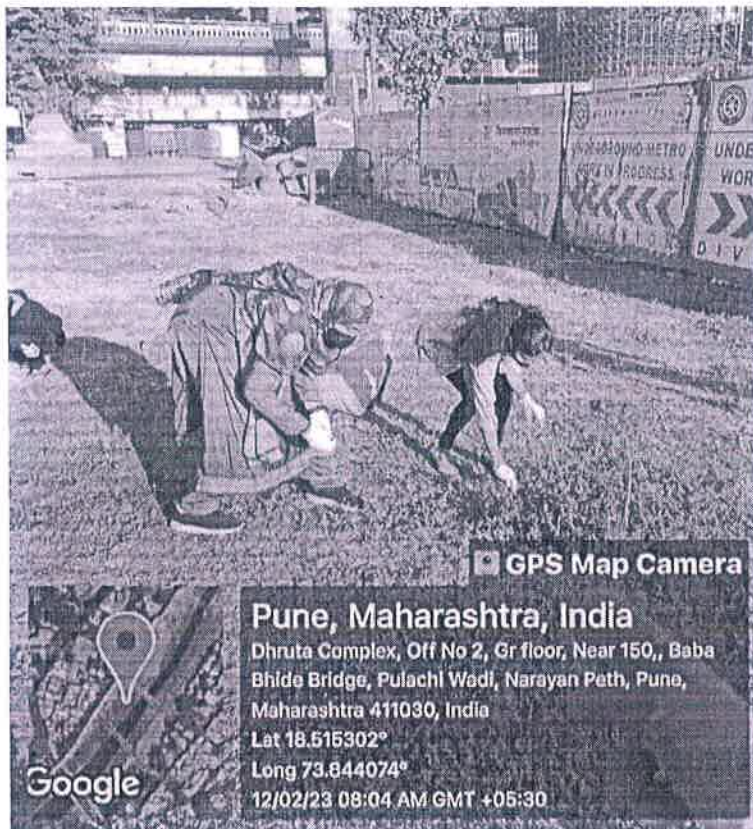

The session ended with snacks which were arranged by Pune Ploggers and vote of Thanks.





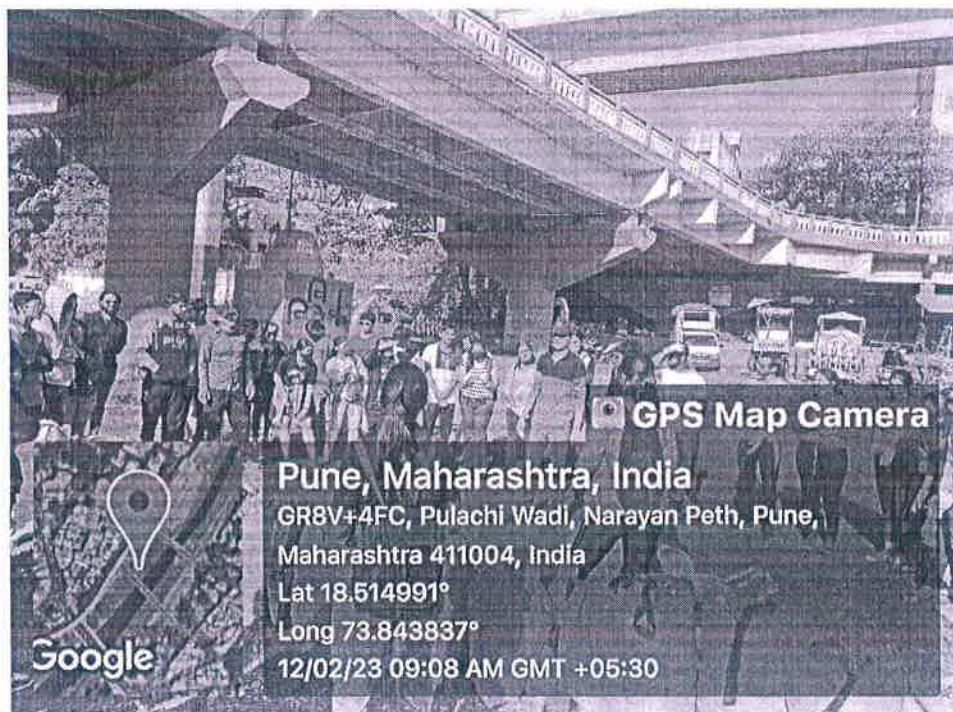

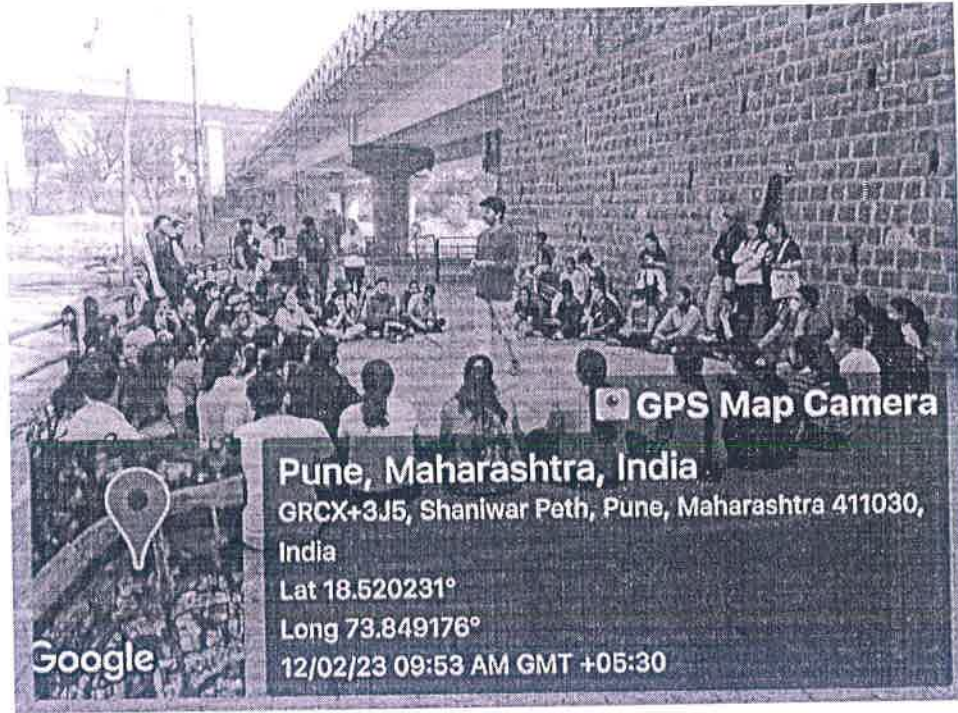
