Sancheti Institute College of Physiotherapy will post its students of Bachelor of Physiotherapy(B.P.Th)/ Master of Physiotherapy (M.P.Th) residents for clinical training at the Armed Forces Medical College, Pune-40 on a NO; repeat NO, remuneration/stipend/pay or any other financial effects to the Armed Forces Medical College.

The Department of Pediatrics, Armed Forces Medical College, will allot suitable cases to the students for physiotherapy and/ or occupational therapy as required and as considered appropriate. The students will conduct the sessions in Pediatric OPD where the Pediatric patients are taken up for assessment and management.

Not more than 2 (Two) students (B.P.Th/ M.P.Th) will be posted for training at Armed Forces Medical College. The training period of each batch of students will be for a block of 2 to 3 months which is the duration for which each student will be assigned to the Armed Forces Medical College. They will attend the Armed Forces Medical College on two days a week as specified (Monday, Thursday) from 09:00h to 13:00h. The students on the remaining days will attend the sessions at their parent institute, Sancheti Institute College of Physiotherapy.

They will come to Armed Forces Medical College on a rotational basis as decided by the faculty of Sancheti Institute College of Physiotherapy The students will attend the Pediatric OPD of the Armed Forces Medical College and report to the HOD, Department of Pediatrics Armed Forces Medical College. The students will attend the OPDs, and ward rounds of the Pediatric doctors concerned under whom they are posted and carry out all physiotherapy/ occupational. therapy related to the concerned cases.

Sancheti Institute College of Physiotherapy and its faculty will ensure strict discipline on the part of the students.

The students, while on rotation to Armed Forces Medical College, if seeking leave will submit leave application to the Principal of Sancheti Institute College of Physiotherapy after informing the concerned authority of both the institutes.

Sancheti Institute College of Physiotherapy faculty who is supervisor of students undergoing degree courses in physiotherapy will be in touch with the clinicians at Armed Forces Medical College and the Principal of Sancheti Institute College of Physiotherapy.





MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

- The memorandum of understanding is made on <u>03/12/2024</u> between Sanchett Institute for Orthopaedics & Rehabilitation College of Physiotherapy (SIORCOP), an institution of Sancheti Group of Hospital, Pune and Army Institute of Cardio-Thoracic Sciences, Pune - 411040 (AICTS).
- Sancheti Institute for Orthopaedics & Rehabilitation College of Physiotherapy will assign its students for clinical training at AICTS, Pune – 411040 on NO remuneration/stipend/pay or any other financial effects to the Army Institute of Cardio-Thoracic Sciences for the clinical training of the students.
- 3. Army Institute of Cardio Thoracic Sciences will allot suitable cases to the students for Physiotherapy as required and as considered appropriate. The students will assess patients and administer the physiotherapy sessions in the intensive care units, inpatient wards and outpatient physiotherapy department only under the guideline/instruction of their teachers or the treating Physiotherapist/consultant of the hospital.
- 4. Upto 04 (four) students will be assigned for training at AICTS. The trainees assigned at AICTS will be on a rotational basis as decided by the faculty of SIORCOP. The students will report to the HOD, Physiotherapy department, AICTS. The students will attend the OPDs and ward rounds of the doctors concerned and carry out all physiotherapy related to the concerned cases.
- 5. SIORCOP and its faculty will ensure strict discipline on the part of the students.
- 6. The students, while on rotation to AICTS, if seeking leave will submit leave application to the concerned authority of both the institutes.
- 7. The training period of each batch of students will be for minimum of one month which is the duration for which each student will be assigned to the AICTS. They will attend the clinical training from Monday Saturday (except institutional holidays at SIORCOP) between 9am 1pm.

No data pertaining to the AICTS patients will be permitted to be published or presented in any forum without prior permission, administrative and ethical clearance from the concerned authorities at AICTS. Research permissions from administration and relevant body will be obtained prior if sought by SIORCOP.
 - (a) Termination of MoU: The MoU may be terminated on mutual consent by prior 30 days written notice in this regard.
 - (b) Amendment to the MoU: During the operation of the MoU, circumstances may arise which may call for alteration or modification of this MoU. These modifications alterations will be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing.
 - (c) Period of validity: This MoU shall be valid for five years from the date of signing of MOU unless renewed or extended in writing the MoU shall stand automatically terminated at the expiry of the period of MOU specified above.
 - (d) Dispute Resolution: Any dispute that may arise during the course of this MOU shall be settled amicably with mutual discussions.

- iii) The parties being acquainted approached each other and both the parties accepted the proposal and the counter proposal and have decided terms and conditions for imparting practical training to the students. The parties to this MOU felt it necessary to reduce the same into writing.

NOW THEREFORE THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

The party of the second part for the sole benefit of its patients and the party of the First part with aim to provide clinical training to its Physiotherapy students have decide to fulfill certain obligation for the mutual benefit and for no monetary consideration.

1) DUTIES AND OBLIGATIONS OF THE PARTY NO. 1:

- a) To provide physiotherapy treatment to the Patients of Party no. 2 under supervision at its Hospital located at 32, Sassoon Road, Pune 411001, daily with basic back up and support for no remuneration whatsoever. The Party No. 1 hereby agrees to depute upto 5 (five) students at a time daily to Party No. 2, who may be accommodated as per the Hospital's convenience. The Party No. 2 shall provide the entire set up for the center and shall look after the maintenance of the same including utilities and housekeeping.
- b) To make available suitable faculty to guide and supervise the student while administering physiotherapy treatment to the patients.
- c) To follow the rules and regulation of the Hospital.
- d) The said College shall acquaint the students with the norms of discipline to be followed while on the campus of the said Hospital, with appropriate notice that in case of any indiscipline by any of the students, the Hospital shall have right to restrict him or her from entering premises of the said Hospital.
