

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REPORT ON BASIC LIFE SUPPORT

A **Basic Life Support (BLS)** training programme was successfully conducted for the **Second Year B.Sc. Nursing students** with the objective of enhancing their knowledge and practical skills in managing life-threatening emergencies. The programme was conducted by **Dr. Mandar Akalkotkar**, an expert in emergency and critical care.

Introduction

Basic Life Support is a vital component of nursing education, as it equips students with essential skills required to recognize and respond effectively to cardiac arrest, respiratory failure, and other emergency situations. This training programme was organized to strengthen both the theoretical understanding and hands-on competence of nursing students.

Objectives of the Programme

- To impart theoretical knowledge regarding Basic Life Support
- To familiarize students with current BLS guidelines
- To develop practical skills in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR)
- To build confidence in handling emergency situations efficiently

Programme Details

The programme was attended by **Second Year B.Sc. Nursing students** and was conducted in two phases:

Phase I: Theory Session

The programme began with a **theory session** conducted by **Dr. Mandar Akalkotkar Sir**. He explained the fundamental concepts of Basic Life Support in a clear and systematic manner. The session covered the following topics in detail:

- Introduction to Basic Life Support
- Chain of survival
- Recognition of cardiac arrest and respiratory arrest
- Steps of adult CPR
- Airway management and breathing techniques
- Use of Automated External Defibrillator (AED)
- Management of choking in adults

Dr. Mandar Akalkotkar Sir used simple language, real-life examples, and interactive questioning to ensure better understanding among students. The students actively participated and clarified their doubts during the session.

Phase II: Hands-On Practical Session

After the completion of the theory session, a **hands-on practical demonstration** was conducted. Students were trained on mannequins and were guided step-by-step through the correct techniques of:

- Chest compressions
- Rescue breathing
- Proper hand positioning and compression depth
- CPR sequence and timing
- Handling emergency scenarios confidently

Each student was given an opportunity to practice under the supervision of Dr. Mandar Akalkotkar Sir. He closely observed the students' performance and provided constructive feedback to improve their skills and accuracy.

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

Health Camp Report

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WORLD HEART DAY





● Health Education:


Attendees will be educated on various important topics, including:

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
Cleanliness is next to godliness


It is mantra of mahatma Gandhiji, father of nation. He demonstrated; propagated and instated for individual and community cleanliness throughout his life.



Col. Jithesh, HOD, AFMC Pune, who addressed cross-department collaboration for crisis management.




The afternoon session featured Paper and Poster Presentation Competitions, chaired by:

This provided a platform for budding researchers and students to showcase their academic work and innovative ideas in healthcare.




SESSION 5

Mr. Anuj Ramteke presented on topic “Roles of leadership in healthcare quality improvement”







The valedictory function was held at 4:30 PM, marking the successful conclusion of the academic segment of the conference.




ANTARANG 2025


